#### **I – General informations.**

The upcoming workshop "*Wetting of solids: Material and kinetic aspects*" will take place at Institut d'Études Scientifiques (IESC) in Cargèse from November 13<sup>th</sup> (early morning) to 14<sup>th</sup> (late afternoon).

IESC is an institute depending on two French universities (Corte and Nice - Sophia Antipolis) and is mainly devoted to the organization of Schools and Workshops. It is located at about 50 km north from Ajaccio.

Participants will be lodged on site. IESC proposes indeed accommodation, lunches and breakfasts. Participants should autonomously take care for their dinner in the village of Cargèse at about 20 minutes walk. It is recommended to have adapted footwear and a flashlight. For non walkers, cars will be available.

## II - Registration, accommodation, abstract submission and dealines.

### 1 – Registration and accommodation.

When accessing for the first time, you'll have to **create an account**. Login and password will then be sent to you by E-mail. You'll then have full access to the online registration form.

### 3 – Deadlines

The deadline for registration and abstract submission is October 7<sup>th</sup>.

## III – About fees.

For accommodation at IESC, price per day will be about 60 € (this includes 1 night, 1 breakfast, 1 lunch).

If necessary, IESC can also book rooms in hotels in Cargèse (between 60 and 80 € per night). This can be done directly from the registration web site. Lunches will then be paid directly at IESC. Thank you to preferentially choose on site accommodation.

Additional 40 € will be asked to each participant by IESC for the welcome reception and workshop dinner.

## IV – Reach Ajaccio and Cargèse.

The nearest airport of Cargèse is Ajaccio (Campo dell'Oro). Transfer to Cargèse from the airport will be organized by IESC if you ask for it in the '*Tranfert to Cargese*' field of the registration web site. Otherwise, there is still the possibility to take a taxi. The price is about 50 € (resp. 75 €) for one way in day times (resp. night times).

Several options are possible to reach Ajaccio.

- 1 - There are regular flights with Air France to Ajaccio but most of them leave from Paris Orly airport. Therefore, if you arrive in Paris Charles de Gaulle, which is the usual airport for international flights, you'll have to account for a **transfer to Paris Orly** in your travel plan. This takes about one hour when traffic conditions are good. Regular shuttle buses are organized between both airports.
- 2 - Air Corsica is proposing regular flights to Ajaccio from Paris Orly, Marseilles and Nice. Informations can be found on the link [www.aircorsica.com](http://www.aircorsica.com) (sorry I found no English version of this web site). Departure from Marseille or Nice will avoid the complicated airport change in Paris but might require two corresponding flights instead of only one.
- 3 - For the lucky participants who can take time, there is the possibility to take a ferry from Marseilles, Nice or Toulon with Corsica Ferries ([www.corsica-ferries.co.uk](http://www.corsica-ferries.co.uk)) or SNCM ([www.sncm.fr](http://www.sncm.fr)). But pay attention to the fact that in November tourism activity is reduced and there are therefore only few ferry rotations between Corsica and the continent.
